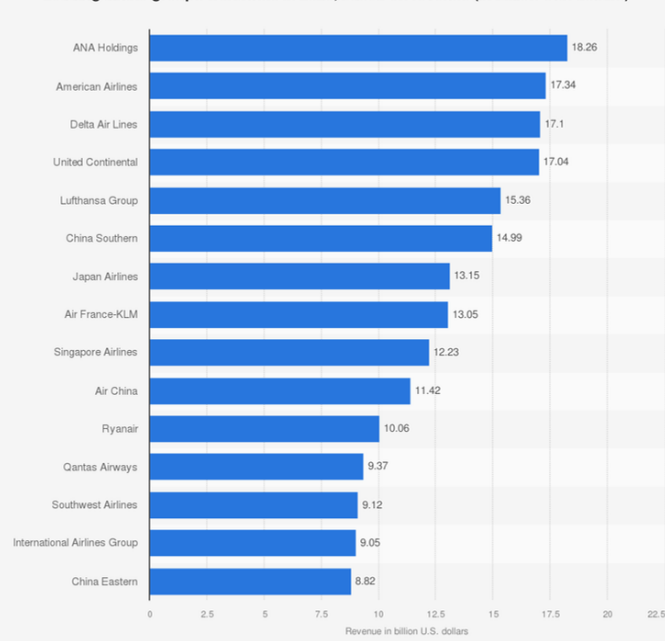

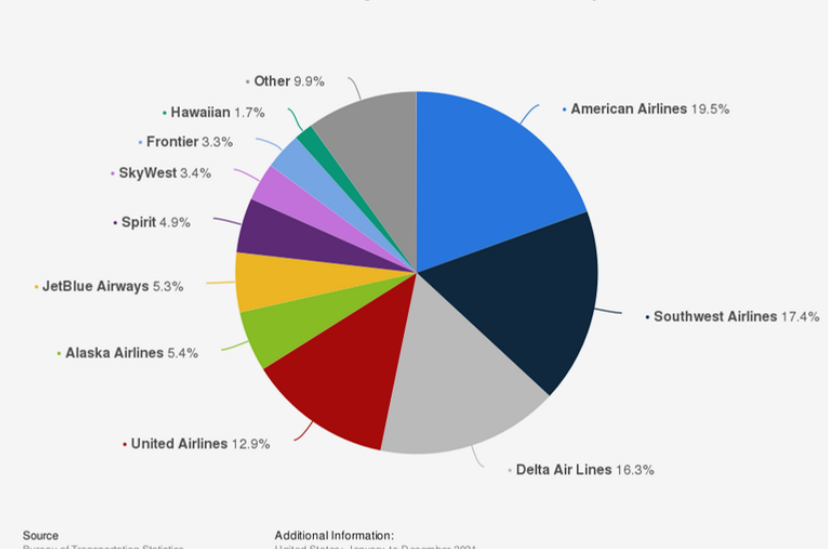

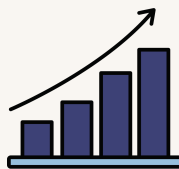
Leading airline groups worldwide in 2020, based on revenue (in billion U.S. dollars)*

- AA has plans to purchase new Boeing 787 planes which is top of the quality in aviation.

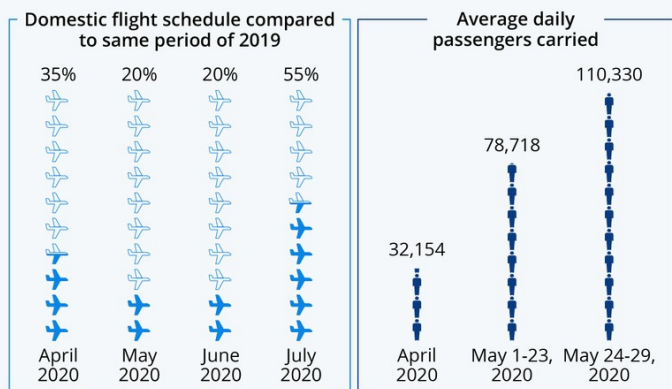


- In 2020 (latest data available), American Airlines generated \$17.3 billion in total revenue, making it one of the largest airline companies in the world in terms of revenue.
